Cities throughout U.S. have already begun work on reducing local emissions and adapting to impacts of climate change. More than 1,000 mayors representing all 50 states and the District of Columbia have signed the Mayors' Climate Protection Agreement. The agreement commits cities to meet or even beat the Kyoto Protocol targets by reducing emissions levels to 7% below 1990 levels by 2012. Mayor Fenty signed the agreement in January 2007. The District recently released its emissions inventory and is anticipating unveiling its draft climate action plan shortly. The DC Environmental Network is launching a webinar series to highlight the excellent work already underway across the country. Many cities across the nation have not only embraced the Mayor's Climate Protection Agreement target but are striving to exceed it. Representatives from the nation's most progressive climate action plans will present and answer questions regarding their cities' plans. The representatives will explain the successes and challenges they have faced in implementing a comprehensive plan with the aim of inspiring local policymakers to follow in these exemplary examples.
